



The Missing Piece Consignment Agreement

The following agreement is made by and between _____ (hereinafter known as Consignor) and The Missing Piece (hereinafter known as TMP). This agreement shall remain in effect indefinitely or until changes in terms and conditions require a new agreement. This agreement shall apply to current and future items consigned.

Sale Proceeds to Consignor

- Consignor will receive 50% of the selling price of consigned items.

Condition of Consigned Items

- Items consigned through TMP must be in good condition. TMP reserves the right to refuse stained, torn, damaged, and/or broken items. If accepted items need repaired or cleaned, in the professional opinion of TMP, repairs and/or cleaning will be done and billed to Consignor. As a matter of convenience, said charge will be deducted from Consignor's account. However, if the item does not sell and there are no proceeds from which to deduct the charge, the Consignor hereby agrees to pay TMP within five days of written notice. Should Consignor send items TMP cannot sell (such as stained, ripped, dirty, broken, or objectionable odors), TMP will immediately contact Consignor who then has 72 hours to remove items or TMP will dispose of them. If a fee is involved to take items to a dump, Consignor will pay fee.

Pricing of Consigned Items

- Consignment is a partnership and TMP strives to get Consignor the highest possible price for his merchandise. Consignor will provide photos and description of item(s) to be consigned. With a photo, age, brand, purchase price and other pertinent information, TMP will provide an estimate of the sales price but can only set the price once a piece is inspected. Consignor hereby understands price may vary upon actual inspection and hereby agrees to TMP pricing. Notification of actual price will be emailed to Consignor. If Consignor does not have email, the report will be mailed.

Length of Consignment Period & Reduction of Sales Price

- The consignment period is 60 days from date items are received by TMP. After 30 days if an item remains unsold, it will be reduced by 15%. Should an item not sell after 60 days, TMP will donate it to a charity, and Consignor will receive a blank tax receipt.

Payment of Consignor Proceeds

- Proceeds from sale of items are paid to Consignor on the 10th day of the month following the month of sale. Proceeds will be automatically mailed to Consignor address provided below. It is the Consignor's sole responsibility to notify TMP of any address change by the last day of the month. If a check needs to be reissued for any reason whatsoever, the stop payment fee will be deducted from the replacement check. If Consignor wishes to pick up his check monthly instead of having it mailed, please let us know at this time.

TMP Liability for Consigned Items

- TMP will exercise all reasonable care of consigned articles; however, items are left at the Consignor's risk. Particularly with smaller items, there is some risk of breakage and shoplifting.

Consignor Representation of Items Consigned

- Consignor represents that he has legal and unencumbered ownership of the property placed for consignment and clear title and right will pass to the buyer. Consignor also represents he knows of no hidden flaws or damage to consigned items which would cause injury to buyer or buyer's residence.
